Consortium Structure Description:

The FEWC is a structured collaboration (not a formal organization) with governance documentation in place. The FEWC is managed by an Executive Committee with members assigned to at least one of five committees. The Executive Committee is made up of:

- Industry Co-Chair
- Workforce Co-Chair
- Secretary
- Chairs of each committee
- Treasurer (or Chair of Funding and Resources can serve in this capacity)
- any active Grant Program Manager(s)

The committees are responsible for developing and implementing specific actions related to the committee purpose. There will be five standing committees:

- Career Awareness
- Funding & Resources
- Policy & Education
- Untapped Labor Sources
- State and National Outreach

Chairs for the Career Awareness, Policy & Education, and State and National Outreach Committees shall be utility or industrial construction representatives. Chairs for the Funding & Resources and Untapped Labor Sources committees can also be from the workforce or education membership of the FEWC. The Chair of committee can add ad hoc resources as required to conduct committee business.

Membership Structure/ Fees Description:

The membership of the FEWC includes:

- Representatives from Electric Utilities within the state of Florida
- Representatives from Industrial Construction Companies within the state of Florida
- Representatives from Industry Associations (i.e, CEWD)
- Representatives from Unions partnered with Energy and Industrial Construction members
- Representatives from secondary and post-secondary educational institutions
- Representatives from Government, including but not limited to: Workforce Florida, Agency for Workforce Innovation, Department of Education, Career and Professional Education, Department of Labor, state, regional and local Chambers of Commerce, regional workforce boards, etc.

The contribution structure for membership in the Florida Energy Workforce Consortium is as follows:

- \$2,000 annual membership contribution – energy/ construction companies
- \$1,000 annual membership contribution – workforce/ education/ associations/ other support

Meeting Schedule Description:

Full FEWC membership meetings are held monthly, and alternate between teleconference and face-to-face meetings held at member/partner locations throughout the state. The meeting calendar is kept on our website, www.fewc.org.

The Executive Committee meets by teleconference monthly.

Each committee meets at least quarterly and usually by teleconference.
